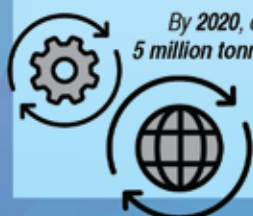
### VIETNAM: MARKET INSIGHTS & HIGHLIGHTS

#### VIBRANT PLASTICS SECTOR

Vietnam's plastic industry is one of the fastest growing sectors in the country, ranking 3<sup>rd</sup> after **Telecommunication and Textile**. There are currently more than **2,200** plastic companies operating in Vietnam with the number of domestic enterprises making up **85%**.

The plastics sector is aggressively promoted by the Vietnam government as it aims to achieve sufficient supply of home-produced raw material through resin production facilities. In parallel, the government issued a blueprint for developing supporting industries such as mould-making, plastic recycling, chemistry and machinery supply.

By 2020, domestic plastics producers will need **5 million tonnes** of raw material for manufacturing.

#### RUBBER SECTOR CONTINUES TO GROW

Vietnam is the **third-largest natural rubber producer in the world**, trailing Thailand and Indonesia.

★ The tyre market is projected to cross **US\$3 billion** by the end of 2021

★ The production of automobiles – passenger and commercial vehicles – Vietnam is expected to establish itself as the global supplier of spare parts and high-value items by 2020
