





MARKET INSIGHT

VIETNAM'S RUBBER INDUSTRY ACHIEVES RECORD EXPORT VALUE OF \$10.2 BILLION IN 2024

In 2024, Vietnam's rubber industry reached a historic export milestone, achieving a total value of \$10.2 billion. This figure encompasses \$3.4 billion from natural rubber exports, \$4.5 billion from processed rubber products (such as tires and gloves), and approximately \$2.3 billion from rubberwood exports. The surge is attributed to a significant increase in export prices, with the average price rising by 26% to \$1,701 per ton. China remained the largest importer, accounting for 72% of Vietnam's rubber export volume. The Vietnam Rubber Association forecasts that in 2025, total rubber exports will continue to grow, reaching between \$11 billion and \$11.2 billion, marking a 10% increase over 2024.

VIETNAM PLASTICS MARKET OVERVIEW (2025–2030)

Vietnam's plastics market is projected to grow from 11.84 million tons in 2025 to 17.76 million tons by 2030, reflecting a CAGR of 8.44%. This expansion is driven by rapid urbanization—expected to reach 51.2% by 2040—and increasing demand across sectors like packaging, construction, and consumer goods. The industry is undergoing significant transformation, emphasizing technological advancements and sustainability initiatives. Key players in the market include Far Eastern New Century, Hyosung Chemicals, Nghi Son Refinery and Petrochemical (NSRP), Billion Industrial Holdings Limited, and SCG Chemicals Public Company Limited (TPC VINA).

U.S. INCREASES EXPORTS OF KEY GOODS TO VIETNAM AT EXTREMELY LOW PRICES: 5% IMPORT TAX, ENABLING VIETNAM TO PRODUCE PRODUCTS COVETED BY HALF THE WORLD.

In early 2025, the U.S. exported over 313,000 tons of plastic resins to Vietnam—an increase of nearly 80% year-on-year. These resins, including polyethylene and polypropylene, are crucial for manufacturing everyday plastic products. With a 5% import tax, the U.S. ranks among the top five countries exporting plastic resins to Vietnam. These materials are then used to produce goods that are in high demand globally, such as packaging and consumer products.

LEGO OPENS \$1 BILLION FACTORY IN VIETNAM TO BOOST ASIA-PACIFIC GROWTH

In April 2025, Danish toymaker Lego inaugurated a \$1 billion factory in southern Vietnam, aiming to enhance long-term growth in the Asia-Pacific region and bring production closer to key markets. This move aligns with Lego's strategy to reduce costs and mitigate supply chain disruptions by situating facilities near major markets. Additionally, the company plans to open a regional distribution center in Vietnam later this year, operated by Kuehne und Nagel, to increase supply chain flexibility. With this expansion, Lego now operates six factories globally and is constructing a seventh in Virginia, USA, expected to commence production in 2027.
